2019 Men's USCSA ECSC MacConnell Division Teams Announced

Babson College's MacIntyre Henderson has been named ECSC MacConnell Division Skier of the Year, while Castleton University's Logan Mackie was selected as ECSC MacConnell Division Rookie of the Year. Coaches from Castleton University earned the ECSC Men's Coaching Staff of the Year award, while the men's team from the University of Connecticut earned the ECSC MacConnell Division Team Sportsmanship Award. In addition, nine men's alpine skiers were selected to the All-Sportsmanship Team.

MacIntyre Henderson raced to two victories, two runner-up results, and one third place finish en route to earning the top spot in the ECSC MacConnell Division individual standings with 560 points. Last year's Skier of the Year and defending USCSA National Champion Paul Rechberger of Castleton University followed Henderson. Rechberger completed the season with 530 points, as he posted four victories to go along with a second place result. Henderson's teammate, Jack Blanchard, finished third overall with 523 points. Blanchard finished within the top-five on seven occasions, including one win, three second place and two third place results. Clarkson University's Thomas Daigle finished fourth in the season standings with 486 points. Daigle won two races, while finishing on the podium three other times. Brian Chambers of the University of Connecticut claimed the fifth spot with 425 points after earning four podium results. New to the division, Castleton's Logan Mackie finished sixth overall with 399 points to earn ECSC MacConnell Division Rookie of the Year honors. Mackie earned one victory, two runner-up finishes, and a third place result during the season.

The men from Castleton University and Babson College will go into the USCSA Eastern Regional Championships as heavy favorites out of the ECSC MacConnell Division, as one point separated the two teams. Both teams finished with four team wins, as Castleton edged Babson for the top spot in the division's team standings. Clarkson University and the University of Connecticut each earned one team win during the season and finished third and fourth overall. St. Anselm College and the University of Massachusetts Amherst placed fifth and sixth to earn the final berth to the regional championships. Calixte Laurent of New England College qualified for the regional championships as an individual, as he completed his rookie campaign in 12th place in the overall season standings.
