**MacConnell Division Athletes Earn Spots on 2014  
Men's and Women's USCSA All-Eastern Region Teams**

Skiers from the USCSA ECSC MacConnell Division were named to the USCSA Eastern Collegiate Ski Conference (ECSC) All-Eastern Region Team based on results from this past weekend's USCSA Eastern Regional Championships at Sugarloaf USA in Carrabassett Valley, Maine.

Brown University's Amanda Engelhardt led the way in the women's field. Engelhardt finished runner-up in the giant slalom portion of the championships. The following day, she captured the slalom title. The combined results gave Engelhardt the overall gold for the USCSA Eastern Regional Championships. Engelhardt's teammate, Emma LeBlanc, took second place overall. LeBlanc earned the giant slalom title, while finishing ninth in the slalom. Castleton State College's Ali Spencer finished third in the giant slalom and sixth in the slalom to earn the combined bronze.

Connor Krell of the University of Massachusetts-Amherst earned the men's combined gold with his first place result in the giant slalom and bronze medal performance in the slalom event. Krell swapped spots on both days with Carter Dowd of Babson College. Dowd finished third in the giant slalom and followed that up with a victory in the slalom. Based on combined USCSA race points from both events, Krell earned a combined 6.16 to edge out Dowd's 12.95. The University of Maine-Farmington's Alex Rose did not finish on the podium in either of the events, but solid skiing earned him the combined bronze. Rose finished fourth in the giant slalom and sixth in the slalom.

The USCSA All-Eastern Region Team is determined based on combined USCSA race points from each event for each competitor. The scoring awards those who race and finish on both days. The top-15 women and men are honored. Below is a full list of recipients.
